- **Workshops and Conferences**



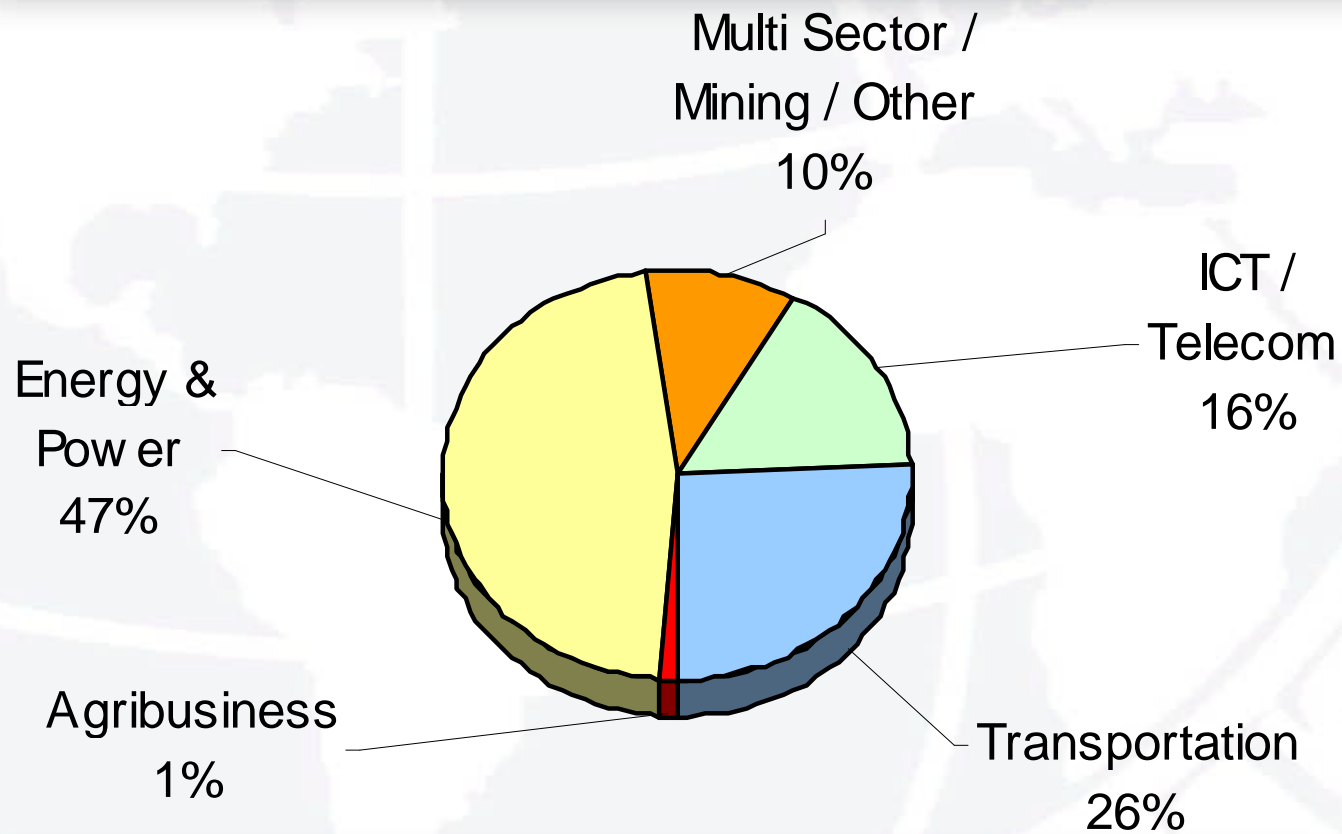
How Does it Work?

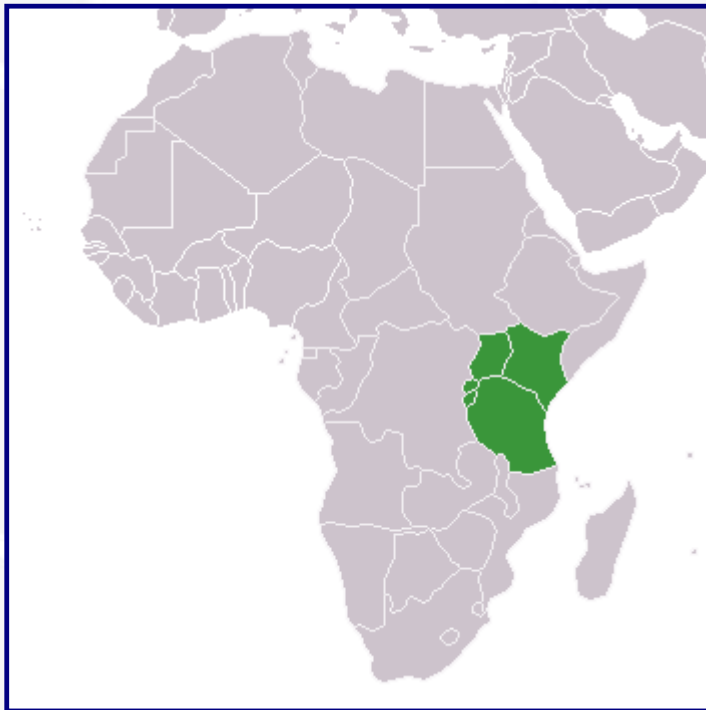

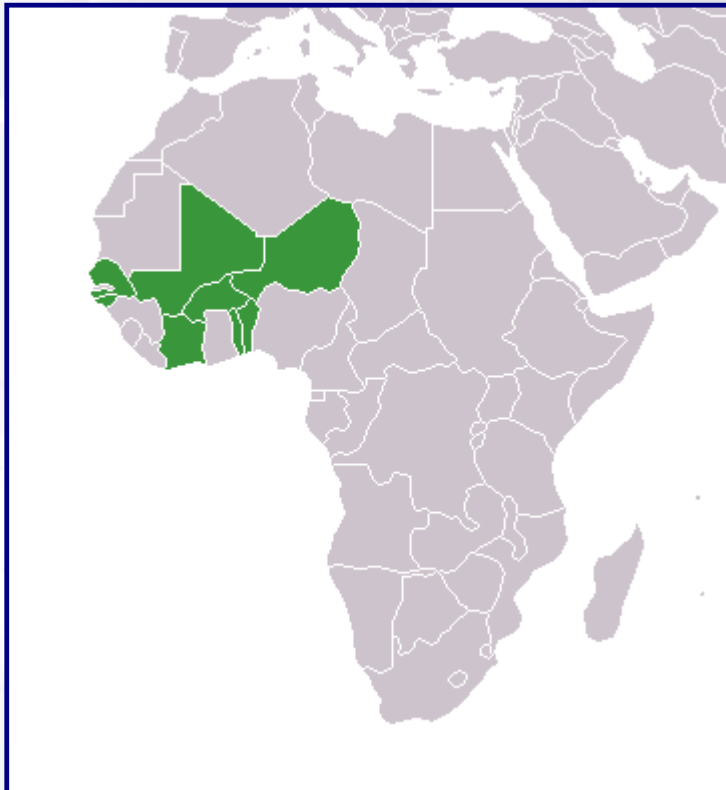
